

Biking trips options starting outside of Chisinau

For all trips most of the route goes through forested hills, country roads, silent & green environment

Route	Biking distance	Duration	Short description
Straseni – Capriana – Condrita - Malcoci	32 km	7,5 hours: 4 hours biking + 2 hours sightseeing stops & lunch + 1,5 hours roundtrip from Chisinau	Trip starts outside of Straseni on the edge of the forest and ends in village Malcoci. First destination is Monastery Capriana. Further through the forest we pay a visit to the Oak of the Stephan the Great, cross more forest to reach the Condrita monastery and finally along the valley of creek Isnovat reach village Malcoci.
Dolna – Hincu - Ulmu	39 km	8 hours: 4 hours biking + 2 hours sightseeing stops & lunch + 2 hours roundtrip from Chisinau	Trip starts in village Dolna, where we visit the museum of Puskin. Not far from the village in the forest we stop at the spring “Zamphira” where Puskin met an fall in love with a Gipsy girl with that name. We continue our route over the hill to the Hincu convent, further to Ulmu lake
Tiganesti – Curchi – Donici	32 km	8 hours: 4 hours biking + 2 hours sightseeing stops & lunch + 2 hours roundtrip from Chisinau	Trip starts on the highway Chisinau-Balti near Tiganesti, and ends in village Donici. On the way we'll visit Tiganesti and Curchi Monasteries, wild boars farm.
Cross of Codru in Calarasi district	46 km	9 hours: 5 hours biking + 2 hours sightseeing stops & lunch + 2 hours roundtrip from Chisinau	Trip starts and ends on the road between villages Reciula & Frumoasa, Calarasi district. We will visit four monasteries & convents of the area, arranged in form of a cross surrounded by forest

For all biking trips starting outside of Chisinau **departure at 9:00** from Central Entrance to the Republican Stadium (in reconstruction) on intersection of Tighina and Sciusev streets.

Return to the same place

Duration: 8 hours 6 hours biking, 2 hours lunch & sightseeing stops Trip starts and ends in Chisinau Departure at 9:00. Return at 17:00. Those who want to rent a bike have to arrive at 8:40.</p>
